What's Going To Happen?

PlaceWorks, the City's consulting firm, will be presenting a "Preferred Land Use Alternative and Traffic Circulation Plan" for the Greenway. Council and Planning Commission members must review, discuss and give feedback on the plan before PlaceWorks can proceed with a project plan, environmental studies and a draft General Plan Amendment.



Why Is This Important?

There is strong sentiment on the part of City Council Members and Planning Commissioners to use sections of the Greenway property for housing. The Greenway Campaign has long advocated for keeping the Greenway green and limiting housing to the areas west of Montgomery High School. The Campaign believes it is critical to have a continuous Greenway that stretches from Spring Lake Park to Farmers Lane – one that is wide enough to ensure the preservation and restoration of our natural environment and offer a wide array of benefits for community members to enjoy now and in the future. What do you want to see happen?

What You Can Do!

This meeting is open to the public and a portion of the meeting will be devoted to public comment. We encourage all Southeast Greenway supporters to attend and show your support for this important addition to Santa Rosa's open spaces, trail system and recreational park system.



A copy of the "Preferred Alternative" plan and the staff report will be available to view and download on the City's website on Friday, March 24th. The Greenway Campaign will provide additional information as it becomes available.
