Springtime Strolls - Take a Guided Greenway Walk!

Where: Montgomery High School Parking Lot (near the tennis court)

The spring weather should be perfect for a walk along the edge of the Southeast Greenway! With three creeks, old trees, wide swaths of open space and beautiful vistas of Bennett Peak and Taylor Mountain, this is the best time of year to learn more about the Greenway and see it at its greenest. The guided walk will give you an understanding of the property's full size, shape and potential for restoration and recreation. You'll see how it fits into a regional plan for connectivity. Come learn about the progress being made and how you can be involved in the planning process for the property in the months ahead.



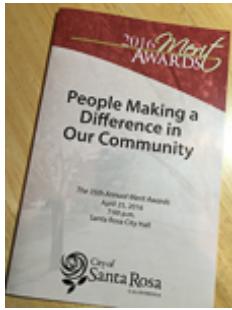

Important Details

Meet up with walk leaders at Montgomery High near the tennis courts. We'll stop by Yulupa Cohousing for a rest stop, continue up the hill to view the Greenway's connection to Spring Lake Park, and then return to the High School. The walk is about 3.5 miles round trip on city streets and sidewalks. Terrain is mostly flat but includes one fairly steep hill. Remember to bring your hat, water, sunglasses, sunscreen and any other items you might enjoy on an urban walk.
