Regional Measure 3 Addresses Transportation Improvements

To help solve the Bay Area's growing congestion problems, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) worked with the state legislature to authorize a new ballot measure that would finance a comprehensive suite of highway and transit improvements through an increase in tolls on the region's seven state-owned toll bridges. Voters in each of the nine Bay Area



counties will consider Regional Measure 3 in June 2018.

Sonoma County projects include upgrades to improve State Route 37 in Marin, Sonoma, Napa and Solano counties and extending the new SMART rail system to Windsor and Healdsburg. The bill also includes a \$150 million grant program to improve bicycle and pedestrian access to regional transit hubs and to close gaps in the San Francisco Bay Trail.
